

Cuddlemocs



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Materials

- Bernat Cuddlespun, one 2-oz skein
- Knitting needles size 10½



Gauge: 7 sts = 2"; 11 rows = 2"

Cast on 29 sts. (Tip: Leave a long piece of yarn to use to sew up the heel.)

Row 1 (Right side): Knit.

Row 2: K9, * P1, K9, repeat from * once more.

Repeat 2 rows until there are 14 ridges on right side, ending with Row 2.

Shape Toe—Alternative 1

Row 1: P1, * K1, P1, repeat from * across row.

Row 2: K1, *P1, K1, repeat from * across row.

Repeat the last 2 rows 4 times more, then work Row 1.

Next row: K1, *P2 tog across row.

Shape Toe—Alternative 2 (Less bulky toe)

Row 1: P1, * K1, P1, repeat from * across row.

Row 2: K1, *P1, K1, repeat from * across row.

Repeat the last 2 rows 3 times more.

Start decreases:

Row 1: Rib 7 st; SSK, K1, K2 tog. Rib 5 st; SSK, K1, K2 tog. Rib 7 st.

Row 2: Rib 7 st, P3, rib 5 st, P3, rib 7 st.

Row 3: Rib 6 st, *K2tog, K1, SSK,* Rib 3, repeat between * *, rib 6.

Row 4: K1, *P2 tog a across row.

Break off yarn, leaving an 8" end. Pull yarn through all sts on needle and draw up tightly. Sew to start of ribbing to form toe. Fold cast on edge in half and seam for center back.

Trim

Cut remaining yarn in half. Then cut into 3" pieces. Tie securely in center and sew to Cuddlemoc.
